Dear friend,

The total marketable amount of unbleached eucalyptus kraft pulp is negligible. The reason is simple: lack of markets (only few customers for phenolic resins impregnated paper, filter papers, carbon paper, corrugated medium). The most important phase in the aggregation of value to eucalyptus pulp is the bleaching stage. For this reason, the offer of unbleached eucalyptus pulp just occurs when a market pulp mill has limitations in its bleaching line and is unable to bleach everything, as it would be its preference.

I'm not familiar with the size of this market, sorry – but the reasons for being so small are the one just mentioned.

However, the few customers who use this pulp are always delighted – thus means that the market is small and the problem is not the quality of the product.

One of the major enthusiastic of this type of pulp is Dr. Dave Hillman.
