**Dear Mr. Cunningham,** good morning.

Thanks for your message and question about the eucalyptus tree.

It is very difficult to identify a given species of *Eucalyptus* based just in the general view of a tree, since many species are very alike. In general, the identification depends on careful analysis of: bark, flowers, leaves, fruits and seeds.

I suggest you to try to get in touch to Dr. David Kleinig, who is one of the best authors in terms of *Eucalyptus* identification.
